Memorise Scripture

The world is full of lies, and we will start to slowly believe them if we aren't prepared and know the TRUTH.

✔ Too much isn't a good thing

When we saturate ourselves with the opinions of the world day after day, the lies begin to sound like truth. That is one of the reasons it is so important to stay anchored to the truth.

Think about TV today. Most shows we watch are pretty clear at communicating some big lies:

- Sex is something you do with someone right away or after only a few dates.
- Getting drunk is something you should do to celebrate something or if you are depressed or just for fun.
- Lying is something we should do whenever it helps get something we want.

The list goes on.

Sadly all of these practices are clearly against God's design. Furthermore, they have consequences we may not always see straight away (TV shows don't always show the consequences).

✔ The truth sets you free

How are we going to know about these consequences if we aren't immersing ourselves in the truth from God's Word?

One of the greatest ways to remember the truth is to memorise it. Memorising scripture helps you keep the truth always within reach.
