“Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel,” Matthew 1:23.

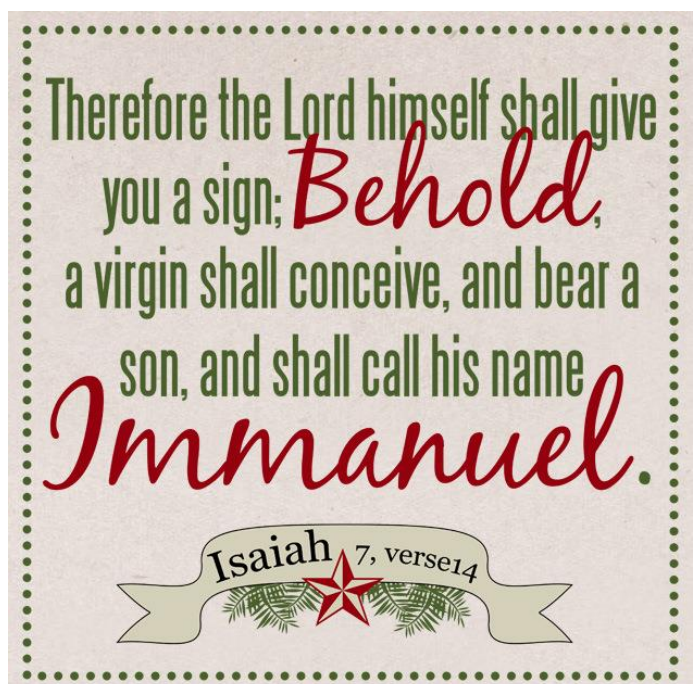
