“Clay Feet?”

An excerpt of Sunday Sermon 12/10/2025

Reading: Daniel 2:1 & 6 & 24-35

To have clay feet means to show signs of vulnerability which amplifies our characteristic weaknesses. Every person has clay feet. Some are more pronounced and noticeable than others, but clay feet we all have. The narrative found in the Book of Daniel relates to the image that King Nebuchadnezzar had in a dream that kept him awake and troubled his mind. Maybe you suffer from a malady that accentuates your failures, fears and worries. Nebuchadnezzar sought guidance from his counsellors, some of whom were astrologers and necromancers. Daniel the young Jewish boy that was taken in exile was a member of his counsel. Nebuchadnezzar had threatened to kill all his spiritual advisors if they could not tell him his dream and interpret the meaning. This would mean all of them would be executed if they failed to meet the king's demand. Daniel asked for time, he met with his friends and they prayed about their dilemma. God gave to Daniel a dream vision which he

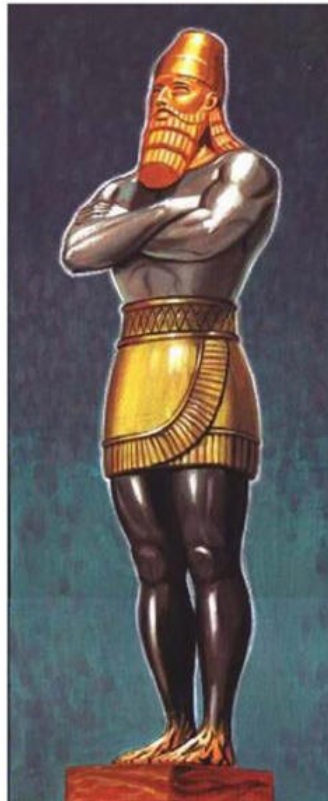

Nebuchadnezzar's Dream Daniel 2:31-45



unpacked with an audience with Nebuchadnezzar. The image in the king's dream consisted of a head of gold representing the Babylonian Empire, the chest and arms representing the Medes and Persians who would come to power followed by the abdomen of the image which consisted of bronze and represented the rise of the Grecian Empire. The two legs of iron represented the rise of the Roman Empire which was eventually divided into east and west.

Nebuchadnezzar's concern focused on the ten toes of the image made up of iron and clay. This represented the rise of a revived Roman Empire that will emerge in the future. We believe that we are witnesses to the revival of Europe as it begins to flex its muscle through NATO (North Atlantic Treaty Organisation).

The lesson brought home by Daniel is that when such an empire is in power Christ Jesus will return to establish His eternal Kingdom on earth. This is represented by the stone cut out of the mountain. So, I appeal to you to not worship man, they are human and all of them have clay feet.

Thank you for your co-operation.

Egg-laying season is from August-April, peaking from September-January. It lays 1-3 eggs, which are incubated by both sexes for about 24-30 days. The chicks leave the nest within 24 hours of hatching and are fed by both parents, fledging after about eight weeks in captivity (probably earlier in the wild).
