Thy Kingdom Come

An excerpt of Sunday Sermon 19/10/2025

Reading: Matthew 6:7-13

The Lord's Prayer construct is an example of the priorities of prayer. Does God answer prayer? With united voice we respond—**YES!!!**

We are testimony to the fact. The prayer of our Lord which became a traditional prayer by Western Nations, regrettably became a ritualistic practise by churches. Preceding the prayer is a warning not to become like the pagans who repeat phrases (mantras to evoke a perceived reaction from their idol gods).

The prayer anticipates the promised Kingdom of God on earth as in Heaven. Never again after the Gospel record do we find believers assembling together and repeating the Lord's prayer. The diligent reader of Scripture will note that this prayer was prayed before the Cross. Remember that Jesus is our Mediator and it is in His name that we now pray.

PROMISED KINGDOM

Jesus our Lord and John the Baptist followed by the disciples preached the pending Kingdom of God. God

promised Israel through the Old Testament prophets that the Messiah would usher in an earthly kingdom with Israel as the primary nation.

POSTPONED KINGDOM

The unfolding of the New Testament makes it clear that the Lord postponed the kingdom and ushered in the non-ethnic entity, the Body of Christ, Christianity. The writings of Paul the Apostle reveal a whole new concept of the church. This was part of God's secret or unrevealed Truth.

PRAYER OF THE KINGDOM

So, the Lord's Prayer was Kingdom related, unattached from the Body of Christ, Christianity.

Now that we know why and where the Kingdom Prayer fits in we understand God's programme for Israel (Kingdom on earth) and the church (Eternal life in Heaven).
