I am Saved

Excerpt of Bruce's message dated Sunday 22/02/2026

Bible Reading: Luke 19:1-10

In all likelihood I speak to the converted about being converted. The narrative of Zacchaeus contains three subjects. The person Zacchaeus, the complaining crowd and the Lord Jesus.

1. Explain the term

The term "saved" as used in the Bible in context sometimes speaks of salvation from physical peril. In other instances it refers to being saved from the world, from self and from a lost eternity. Using the latter let's consider the following.

2. Expose the Truth

Our Lord visited Zacchaeus a despised tax collector who had cheated the people. He was despised by the crowd who complained when Jesus offered him salvation. Often we are exposed to the Truth and we resist it in an open act of rebellion. Too often when Truth is resisted it ceases to be significant in our lives and therefore, its not impactful.

3. Express the Transformation

The despised tax collector repented and received redemption.. His act of wanting to repay those who he cheated four times more than what he stole from them is an indication of his knowledge of the Old Testament recorded in **Exodus 22:1** *"If the thief sought restitution he needed to pay back four (4) times what he had stolen. When we express the spirit of transformation it should be followed by restitution with those that we harmed or those to whom we hold a grudge."*

An old Sunday School song says it all:

*"I met Jesus at the crossroads,
Where the two ways meet,
Satan too was standing there,
And he said, "Come this way,
Lots and lots of pleasures,
I will give to you today."*

*But I said, "No, there's Jesus here;
See what he offers me,
Down here my sins forgiven
Up there a home in heaven."
Praise God! That's the way for me."*
