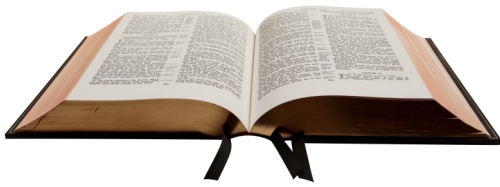
Confess Change

We encourage all our members and adherents to please participate by **bringing along to Church**, (or you may drop off any donations on Wednesday morning), non-perishable food items that will be distributed to folks who are less fortunate than ourselves.

Suggestions: *Small packets* of tea, coffee, sugar, condensed milk.

Rice, Macaroni/pasta, Mielie Rice, Samp & Beans. Pkts of soup, stock cubes, pkts of seasoning. Cereals like Morevite, Instant Mielie Mielie or Mielie Meal. Canned foods like: jam, tuna, pilchards (no spicy fish please), mix veg, tomato & onion, beans, etc., Imana Soya Mince, peanut butter, small bottles or oil or Holsum bricks, small pkts of biscuits, etc.



“Prayer is not a way of making use of God; prayer is a way of offering ourselves to God in order that He should be able to make use of us. It may be that one of our great faults, in prayer, is that we talk too much and listen too little.”

We might call this “the listening prayer,” and it’s a practice we need to develop. We need to find a way to get alone with God, to speak to Him in earnest, taking time to listen to the urgings of the Spirit and the instruction of His Word. We must say, “Teach me Your way, O Lord; I will walk in Your Truth” (Psalm 86:11).

Are we talking so much that we don’t hear what God says? If so, we need to learn the art of the listening prayer.

We need to set aside the time
To read God’s Word and pray,
And listen for the Spirit’s voice
To guide us, in His way.
